



Appointed And Anointed

Text: John 14:12

I tell you the truth, anyone who believes in ME will do the SAME WORKS I have done, and even GREATER works, because I am going to be with the Father. John 14:12

Greater Works (in the Greek): On A Grand Scale – Numerous – In Abundance

Your Part:

1. God has **APPOINTED** you to fulfill certain assignments! John 15:16,
 - Each one has been appointed his or her own tasks. I Corinthians 3:5
 - **YOU** are Christ's **AMBASSADOR** on this earth. II Corinthians 5:20
 - Everywhere you go—you represent Jesus.
 - **YOU** can change **YOUR** world if you are willing to accomplish the appointments that God has appointed you to do.
 - Be sensitive to the leading of the Holy Spirit in your **EVERY DAY** life.
 - Start Praying:
 - God, I ask You to direct my steps today.
 - Show me those divine connections and divine appointments that You have for me.
 - Be aware of **YOUR** surroundings and the people around **YOU**—at work, in the grocery store, in Starbucks, etc.
 - Look around and say:
 - God, is there anything I can do for You here today?
 - Is there any person I need to touch for You?
 - I'm available God and I'm always on assignment for **YOU!**
 - How do you fulfill **YOUR** destiny?
 - One day at a time.
 - Get up every day and make yourself available to God and **YOUR** destiny will unfold before you.
 - Follow the leading of the Holy Spirit and God will use you more and more.
 - The Holy Spirit is leading you when:
 - A. You sense the compassion of God rise up inside of you toward a person.
Mark 1:41
 - B. You feel drawn to a person.
 - C. You have someone on your heart or mind for a few days.
2. God has **ANOINTED** you to fulfill your assignments and purpose. I John 2:20 & 27
 - You don't have to pray for the anointing. You **ARE** anointed whether you feel like it or not. It is a state of being for the believer.
 - You are a container of God's power!
 - The anointing is the presence of the Holy Spirit in you—giving you the power you need to fulfill your assignments and your destiny.
 - When you don't know what to say to a person or how to pray for a person, the anointing will rise up in you and help you and equip you! Luke 4:18-19



- You have the **ANOINTING IN YOU** to:
 - Set people free!
 - Lead people to the Lord.
 - Lay hands on the sick and see them recover!
 - Take authority over Satan and set people free from his power!
- You have the power of God **IN YOU** and you should allow it to flow through **YOU** to help hurting people.
- You are a carrier of God's power!
- Don't be stingy with what God has given you!
- God has **ENTRUSTED YOU** with the power of the Holy Spirit to do the works that Jesus did!
- Become more conscience of the **ANOINTING IN YOU**—depend on that anointing.
