LUKE 4:1-15 REVIEW:

- Jesus had overcome Satan in the wilderness and came out in the power of the Holy Spirit.
- When you have gone through a time of testing and temptation and you overcome the enemy, you will go to another level in your spiritual walk.

LUKE 4:15-21:

The Ministry of Jesus

1. It was the custom of Jesus to worship God in church.

- Jesus shows us that it is absolutely necessary to worship God in church on a consistent basis.
- We are encouraged when we are together and we need each other. *Hebrews 10:25*
- Being planted in a church will cause you to flourish. *Psalms 92:13*
- Being consistent in going to church will change your life.

2. Jesus declared what the Bible said about Himself.

- Jesus shows us that He was fulfilling the prophecies in the Bible. *Isaiah 61*
- Just like Jesus, we have to search the Bible, see what it says about us, believe it, and declare it!
- The Word of God has already defined who you are and it is your true mirror.
- When you know the truth, it will set you free.

3. People were the mission of Jesus and compassion was His motivating force.

- Jesus is concerned about all people.
- The Bible talks about Jesus being full of compassion. *Matthew 9:36, 14:14, 15:32, 20:34*
- Greek translation for “compassion” is inward affection and mercy.
- God wants us to be vessels of His compassion.
- We need to quit trying to “fix” people—and instead—show them the love of God!



4. The purpose of the anointing on YOUR life is to proclaim the Good News and set people free like Jesus did.
- Jesus came not to condemn the world, but save the world!
 - The word “preach” means to proclaim, to declare, to announce, and to herald a message.
 - Tell what Jesus has done for you.
 - God will give you divine assignments and will use you to set the captives free and heal the brokenhearted.
 - God anoints YOU to do what He has called YOU to do and He has called you to help people.

Definition of the anointing: The anointing is the presence of the Holy Spirit in you—giving you the power you need to do the work that Jesus did and fulfill your destiny. It is God’s grace, power, strength, and ability working in you through the Holy Spirit.

5. Jesus was persecuted and we will be to.
- It’s unavoidable. *Matthew 5:10-12, II Timothy 3:12*
 - When you step out in faith and allow the Holy Spirit to use you, people will recognize the authority you have.
6. Jesus healed people everywhere He went.
- The Gospels show us that Jesus majored on 3 things: preaching the Good News, teaching the Word, and healing the sick.
 - Train yourself to pray for your family when they sick.
 - When you lay hands on the sick, the power of God is present to bring healing.
 - Just like Jesus, you are a container of God’s power.
 - The power of the Holy Spirit is in you to help people, bless people, and set them free from the devil’s bondage.
