



“God is Our Source of Supply”
Text: Matthew 6:24-34

There are two different ways of doing power - the world's way and God's way. Both are very different. One way the world uses power is through money. The world trusts in money to get their needs met. But in Matthew 6:24-34 Jesus shows us why we can trust God as our source of supply.

In Matthew 6:24-25 Jesus is saying you serve what you fear. What Jesus is revealing to us is that you can worship money even when you don't have any. He is exposing the faulty belief that money is our source of supply. Fear of not having enough money puts you as a servant to it.

Matthew 6:32-33 says that the pagans chase after money to get their needs meet, yet God doesn't use money to meet the needs of the birds. God can provide for us a million ways outside of money – so why chase after money as if that is your one and only way to survive? Instead of seeking money, we should seek to understand the kingdom.

In Matthew 6:26 Jesus asks us to “look” at creation. He's not just asking us to consider what He's saying one time. He's telling us that this should be a regular practice. In fact, this was a regular practice in the Old Testament. Read Psalm 104. God faithfully cares over everything in His creation from every bird to blade of grass. If He looks after these lesser things how much more will He look after us.

He knows in advance what we need before we even ask. That means that He has made provision in advance of the need. Have confidence that He sees into your future, He goes ahead of you, and therefore has already prepared the provision to your need.
