Leviticus 16 – Seeing Jesus In The Old Testament

THREE CORE THOUGHTS:

1. The purpose of the Old Testament is to reveal the Lord Jesus Christ in God's great plan of redemption.
2. This is how the Old Testament and the New Testament are tied together: they both tell the same story.
 - The Lamb of God who was slain from the foundations of the world. *Revelation 13:8*
 - Everything must be fulfilled that is written about Me in the Law of Moses, the Prophets and the Psalms. *Luke 24:44*
 - And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, He explained to them what was said in all the Scriptures to us. *Luke 24:27*
 - Were our hearts not burning within us, while He talked with us on the road and opened the Scriptures to us? *Luke 24:32*
3. The Old Testament is an orderly, progressive, unfolding revelation from God of the blood covenant He entered into with man through the Lord Jesus Christ.

DAY OF ATONEMENT (PART OF THE “LAW” OF MOSES):

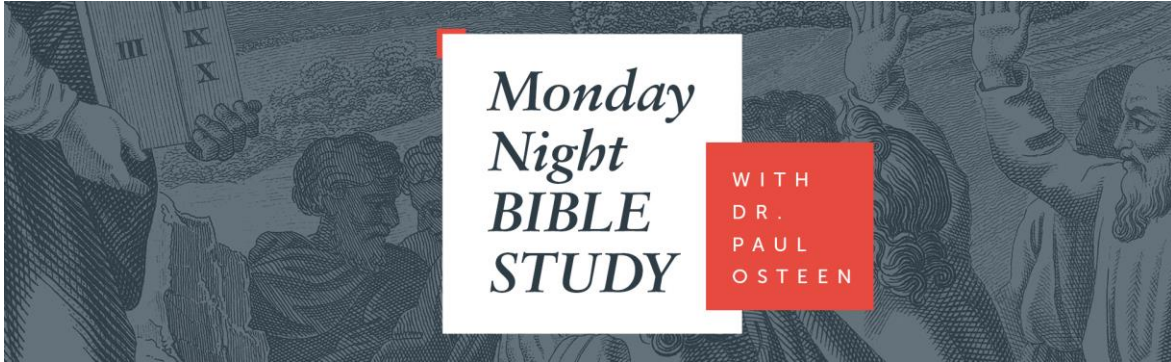
Understanding The Passage:

- It is finished! The veil in the temple was torn in two from the top to the bottom. *Mark 15:38*
