Notes on Acts 10.

We break down Acts 10 in 3 parts.

- 1. Memorial Prayers
- 2. Mistaken Prejudices.
- 3. Manifested Presence.

Part One MEMORIAL PRAYERS.

(Acts 10:1-5, repeated in verse 31)

- God does nothing on earth as it is in Heaven but through PRAYER.
- A prayer is never WASTED. When we pray "in Jesus Name" God has the right to direct those prayers to what and where that God needs them to go. WE are reminded that many times "we don't always know not how to pray!" But Christ purifies our prayers
- A prayer NEVER dies. Like rain, our prayers goes up, comes down, then goes back up. Every prayer you've ever prayed still lives and works!

(Revelation 5:8/8:1-5)

God Listens.

No prayer request is <u>too BIG</u> that God is intimidated, no request <u>too SMALL</u> that He would be insulted.

God's answer to our prayers are always YES or KNOW.

YES and Amen to every promise, KNOW as in - God KNOWS best. God KNOWS exactly WHEN and HOW the answer should come. Always a Win/When!

Part Two Mistaken Prejudice. (Acts 10:5-43) We must overcome all pre-judgements, and accept our "ministry of reconciliation" to and for EVERYONE!

(2 Corinthians 5:18 -21)

"All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation:

that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting people's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation.

20 We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, <u>as though God were making his appeal through us.</u> We implore you on Christ's behalf: Be reconciled to God.

21 <u>God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.</u>
